the Boy Scouts of America's premier High Adventure™ base, challenges Scouts and Venturers with more than 200 square miles of rugged New Mexico wilderness. Backpacking treks, horseback cavalcades, and training and service programs offer young people many ways to experience this legendary country.

Here's your chance to do just that. Philmont is a high adventure program of strenuous backpacking in the **Sangre de Cristo Range of the Rocky Mountains** near Cimarron, New Mexico. Troop 574 will be sending two crews to Philmont in 2010. Each crew consists of 12 Scouters of which 3 to 4 must be adults and is a backpacking expedition on the Philmont Ranch for 12 days.

If you are interested, return this form with a \$100 deposit (Check to Troop 574). Submission and deposit does not guarantee a spot on the Crew but consideration will be made on a first come basis first serve.

Minimum age: Philmont participants must be at least 14 by January 1 of the year they attend and have completed the eighth grade prior to participation. To avoid disappointment, please do not request or expect exceptions! Requirements for Philmont participation cannot be relaxed. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Philmont also has maximum height/weight ratio requirements to insure that participants are physically capable of the expedition.

The fee to Philmont / Circle 10 for the expedition trek is \$910.00. Costs are included to cover the fee to Philmont and the bus transportation while traveling to and from Philmont. No meals are included as part of the fee for the transportation days. Other miscellaneous cost will apply at Philmont depending on which trek is taken. The deposit will not be refunded **if accepted to the Contingent** and will go toward the total cost of the trek. If you must cancel for any reason your total fee is not refundable but may be transferred/traded to another Scouter on the waiting list to attend. Troop 574 must pay for all 24 crew positions whether or not we fill all 24 positions. So be sure that your are willing to make this commitment to the crew.

Mandatory campouts / hikes and classroom work are already being scheduled between now and June 2010 and is not included in the \$910 fee. These hikes and classroom work are to assure each participant of the crew is prepared for the trek and learn to work together as a team. First Aid and CPR classes along with wilderness first aid classes will be at the participants cost but we will try to find someone to teach the classes at reduced costs.
